What does Courage to Soar have to offer?

- Full tuition and textbook sponsorship for the **Administrative Assistant – Advanced Studies Program** at Willis College **Note:** Eligible applicants are required to have a source of income for living expenses and childcare in place before entering the training program.
- Willis College has tailored a 24-week Diploma Program in **Administrative Assistant – Advanced Studies** for Courage to Soar-sponsored students.
- Four week job placement and employment agency referrals after graduation.
- Access to academic, advocacy, referral, peer support and counseling before, during and after training.
