Under the **Courage to Soar Program**, Minwaashin Lodge Aboriginal Women's Support Centre is offering training and career development opportunities to highly motivated and committed candidates interested in pursuing a career in Office Administration. What does Courage to Soar offer?

- Full tuition and textbook sponsorship for the **Office Administration Program** at Willis College or **Office Administration** at Algonquin College. Note: Eligible applicants are required to have a source of income in place for living expenses before entering the training program.
- Willis College has tailored a 16-week Diploma Program in Office Administration for Courage-to-Soar-sponsored students that includes a 4-week "transition to academic learning" module.
- Forty-hour job placement and employment agency referrals after graduation.
- Access to academic, advocacy, referral and peer support before, during and after training.
