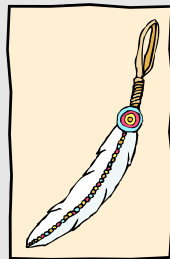

The STORM team is available to assist women involved in the sex trade. The outreach team can assist women with immediate medical, safety and shelter needs.

**The STORM team provides:**

Information and referral to community supports i.e. legal, medical and housing

Transportation to emergency shelters, hospitals, detoxification unit and other deemed appropriate locations

Basic supplies i.e. hygiene products, clothing, bagged lunches and snacks

Harm reduction supplies i.e. condoms, crack pipes, needles
